**Eligibility requirements:**

- Any currently enrolled student in an ABET accredited program in civil engineering or related field within the Los Angeles Section.
- Applicant will be registered as an undergraduate or graduate student in the fall of the year for which he/she is applying. Applicants must be a student member of the Society in good standing at the time of application and award.
- The scholarships may be awarded only to those students who will employ them to continue their formal undergraduate or graduate education at a recognized educational institution.
- Previous recipients of this scholarship are eligible to apply in any succeeding competition for these awards provided the other requirements of eligibility are satisfied.
- Selection is based on the applicant’s justification of award, educational plan, academic performance and standing, potential for development, leadership capacity, ASCE activities, and financial need, **note** that your ability to follow these instructions will count in your scores.

- 1 : Scholarship at \$3,000\*
- 1 – 3 : Scholarships at \$2,000\*

- Attach resume which includes education, work experience, extracurricular activities (notable is your involvement in **ASCE**), and honors.
- Attach a transcript (unofficial is acceptable with advisor digital signature)
- Essay: Why are you pursuing a career in civil engineering or related field?  
How has your ASCE involvement helped you personally and professionally?  
What are your future goals as a practicing Civil Engineer?  
Address each essay line item & the essay should be no more than **500** words.
- Provide a bio that should not exceed **200** words.
- Provide a photo of yourself.
- Have your application signed by your faculty advisor.
- Submit your application as one single .PDF file, saved as “Lastname\_Firstname\_School.PDF”.
